Dear Parents:

Please be advised that the time to order the Advanced Placement (AP) test for Calculus, Chemistry, and Physics is quickly approaching. Each student that wishes to take one of these tests **MUST pay the required \$94 (per exam) on or before Thursday, February 8th.** Any student that has not paid for the AP test by this date will not be allowed to take the examination. The AP Chemistry test will be administered on Monday, May 7th from 8am until noon. The AP Physics test will be administered on Tuesday, May 8th from noon until 4pm. The AP Calculus tests, both AB and BC, will be administered on Tuesday, May 15th from 8am until noon.

We have been preparing for these exams since the beginning of this academic year. We highly encourage each of our students to give considerable thought and discernment about taking the AP exam. We have every confidence that our students will have a positive experience from taking this examination. Families can access the score required for college credit on the following website:


