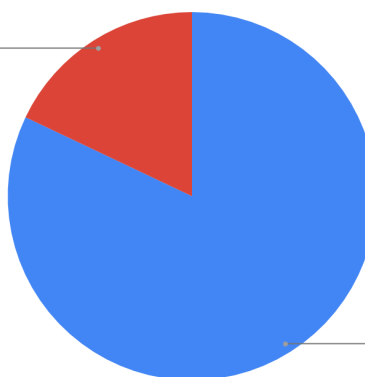
Boys
