Red Ribbon Week, a national drug prevention program, runs from October 23 to November 3. St. Joe students and teachers participated in the following events to promote substance abuse awareness.

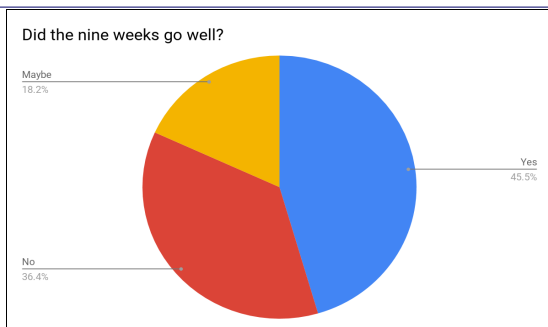
- On Monday, SADD members will wear designated colors representing the statistic that one out of 10 people struggle with some form of substance abuse.

Meet & Greet - Huntington Prep—Isaiah M.

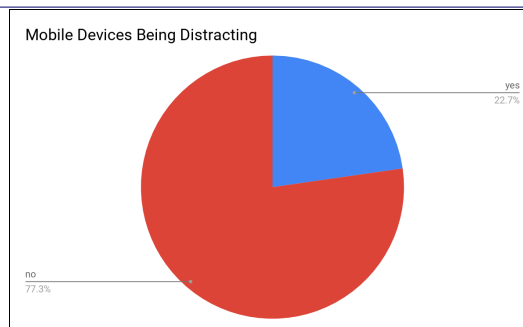
