Information about our program:

- We offer 4 levels of Spanish.
- Spanish 4 is an Honors Class and dual credit through Marshall University.
- Our students collaborate in one of their projects with HS students from Mexico.
- Students that have taken Spanish in Middle School can take a placement test to get a Spanish 1 HS credit and start their path in Spanish 2.
- Students in each level take the Spanish National Examination.
- We have a Hispanic Honor Society, an Honor Society for students in Spanish 3 and above and/or those who have completed their three Spanish credit requirement.
