The students must have earned an A in Algebra I, pass a written entrance exam with at least an $85 \%$, and have a written recommendation from the Algebra I teacher.

Along with this letter you will find the material that will be included in the entrance exam linked on the SJHS Graduation Requirements website. Please review the material and practice accordingly. The entrance exam will be administered in Room 203 at SJHS on Wednesday, August $10^{\text {th }}$ promptly at $10: 00 \mathrm{am}$. Students will have 60 minutes to complete the exam. Please check our website, www.stjosephhs.org, for updated information.

Please think carefully before deciding if this is the path for your student. This will dictate what options are available in the subsequent years, as per our Course Sequencing chart. Also, no other math classes can be combined until the senior year.
