The entrance exam will be administered in Room 203 at SJHS on Wednesday, May 19th promptly at 3:15 pm. There will be another one given in August, date to be determined.. Students will have 60 minutes to complete the exam. Please check our website, www.stjosephhs.org, for updated information.

Please think carefully before deciding if this is the path for your student. This will dictate what options are available in the subsequent years, as per our Course Sequencing chart. Also, no other math classes can be combined until the senior year.
