Project Overview

To achieve our objectives, St. Joseph Central Catholic High School leadership has launched the *Restoring our Building of Traditions Capital Campaign*. The overall estimated financial need to accomplish all of these projects is \$385,000. The campaign has been split into two phases, so that we can complete the most critical needs of the school first. Safety is one of our biggest concerns, so completing Phase 1 over the summer months while our students are not in the building is our main priority. Phase 2 can be completed once the additional funds have been raised.

How to Pledge Your Support

St. Joseph Central Catholic High School seeks to raise a minimum of \$385,000 through the efforts of the campaign. Every member of our school community is integral to the success of reaching our goal; therefore, each family is asked to prayerfully consider making a pledge to the best of their ability.

Each family is asked to consider a pledge of only \$18 a week or more over three years. After a \$300 down payment, this is \$75 per month for 36 months or \$1,000 per year, which is a total pledge of \$3,000.
